1999-2008

1999 RESOLUTIONS:

- Increased Subordinate dues to \$20 per annum per member, effective January 1, 2001, which increases dues to state - \$16 and national - \$4.00, or \$1.50 per quarter, to show on the Secretary's March 31, 2001 report.

2000 RESOLUTIONS:

- NONE

2001 RESOLUTIONS:

- Requested a \$5.00 or more volunteer donation for the next two years, from all regular and golden sheaf subordinate members, to offset operational costs of Friendly Hills and Ohio State Grange, meet "matching fund" requirements and help to balance the budget.

2002 RESOLUTIONS:

- Automatically increases the subordinate dues \$2.00 per annum, biennially, the year of elections, effective January 1st, 2005 and report on March 31st 2005 Secretary's report. This would be a \$.50 per quarter, per member. This increase would take place only if there was NOT an increase in state membership of 5% per year. If membership increases 5% per grange year, there will be no increase. By-Laws change: Article XI, Section 1.
- Increases Ohio State Grange dues by \$5.00 effective January 1, 2003 to pay for the National Grange dues increase. By-Laws change: Article XI, Section I.

- Adopted the "Statement of Investment Policy" dated April 1, 2001 and Amended February 8, 2006 presented by the Executive Board.

- Ohio State Grange Executive Board developed a family membership dues plan to present to the 2009 Delegate Body at the Annual State Session.

- Resolved that National Grange reinstate the honor bestowed on 50 year members by not assessing a dues payment for the balance of their membership.
- Resolved that the subordinate Grange pay the dues of their members who are on active military duty.

2009 RESOLUTIONS:

- Resolved that the Ohio State Grange eliminate the \$600 monthly living expense for the Ohio State Grange Master/President.
